# MINUTES OF TRUSTEES' MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 29TH AUGUST 2023 AT 6.00PM

# FINANCE:

Prior to Covid the Club had been on a sound financial footing although the last time the bar made a profit was in 2019.

This year the Trustees have spent money on infrastructure – roof repairs, hard wiring, fire equipment upgrading.

We face a stark decision – do we build on what we have or do we follow a different direction.

Footfall and activities and therefore income are both in decline.

### We face some options:

- 1. Stay as we are making huge losses with potential for doubling of Equal Contributions.
- 2. Make full use of it with activities for the whole community
- 3. Opening as a Community hub open to all groups to hire. Keeping bar with an expensive open license and not serving draught beers due to cooling costs.
- 4. Passing the whole licensed area to a limited company with directors with personal liability to run and be responsible for all costs while paying an economic rent of c.£50,000.
- 5. Sell the site: Unlikely to gain support of 75% of 420 votes.

Currently the Equal Contribution fees are propping up the bar to the tune of £1500 pcm.

Sky TV is costing £671 pcm and BT TV £333 pcm.

#### OTHER BUSINESS

Fireworks: Need volunteers arranged by Residents Committee for tidy uppers.

Fireworks to have café open and a raffle. Kim to be given budget.
